SUMMARY

Plans, designs, and directs construction of water distribution and/or sewer collection projects by performing the following duties. Employee shall possess strong communication skills and solid knowledge of civil engineering design principles. Employee plans and organizes engineering activities including long and short term project planning and design. Employee shall also provide responsible advice and counsel to staff and Management on a variety of engineering issues. Employee shall maintain an enthusiastic, self-reliant, and self-starting approach to meet the responsibilities of this job. Employee shall strive to anticipate work to be done and initiate proper acceptable direction for the completion of work with a minimum of supervision and instruction.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

Bachelor's degree (B. A.) from four-year college or university; and a minimum 4 years related experience and/or training is desired with a Professional Engineer (P.E.) License.

COMPENSATION

Employee shall be compensated on an exempt salary basis to be determined at time of hire. Employee shall be paid bi-weekly (26 times a year).
