Re: Barberville Rd. Water Service Disruption for Water Meter Relocations

Dear Customer;

Please know that a proposed lane widening on Barberville Rd., as a result of the new Covington Subdivision by Kolter Land Partners (developer), will require meter boxes to be relocated (outside of road improvements) for the following addresses:

- 10854 Barberville Rd.
- 10857 Barberville Rd.
- 10858 Barberville Rd.
- 10866 Barberville Rd.
- 10873 Barberville Rd.

As a result of these meter boxes needing to be relocated, Lancaster County Water & Sewer District (LCWSD) will be temporarily turning off water service for the above mentioned addresses.

On Wednesday, October 11, 2017, LCWSD crews will be connecting relocated water meter boxes to the existing waterline as part of the road improvements planned on Barberville Rd., due to the Covington development. Water service to your property is planned to be disrupted from 10:00 am until approximately 4:00 pm. We apologize for this inconvenience; however, LCWSD's crews will ensure water is restored as quickly as possible, following the new water meter connection. Please understand that when the water is turned back on, there may be air accumulated in the lines. Not utilizing water during the aforementioned timeframe will help minimize air accumulation in the lines.
