**“SMOKE TESTING AND SEWER SURVEY”**  
**LANCASTER COUNTY**

During the next couple of months, Lancaster County Water & Sewer District and Gavel and Dorn Engineering, a consultant for the District, will be conducting a physical survey of the sanitary sewer system in the Williams Circle, Kaywood Drive, Drywood Circle, Green Peach Road, Pacer Drive, and Oakdale Drive areas. The information gained from this study will be used to improve the sewer system in these areas.

The study will involve the opening and entering of manholes in the surrounding streets and easement areas. An important task of the survey will be the “smoke testing” of sewer lines to locate breaks and defects in the sewer system. The smoke that you may see coming from the vent stacks on houses, manholes or holes in the ground is NON-TOXIC, CREATES NO FIRE HAZARD, IS GRAY TO WHITE IN APPEARANCE WITH AN ODOR OF BURNING PAPER AND IS HARMLESS (EXCEPT TO PERSONS WITH SUCH LUNG DISEASES AS EMPHYSEMA).
