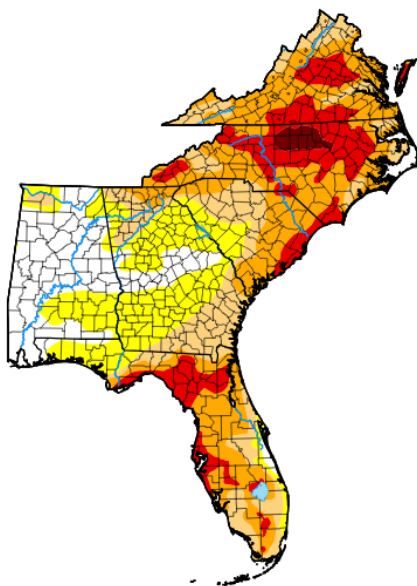


Catawba-Wateree LIP Trigger Status Summary for 07/01/2026 and Changes Compared to 06/16/26

NOTE: All three (3) metrics must return to LIP Stage 1 or higher to exit out of the Stage 2 Drought Conditions. 2 of 3 metrics have dropped in the last 2-week period.
